The Bible reminds us that we must be concerned about lost souls. “For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost” (Luke 19:10). “And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen” (Matthew 28:18-20).

This is also a great opportunity for the Church to get to know its neighbors. We are supposed to be the light of the world (cf. Matthew 5:14).
