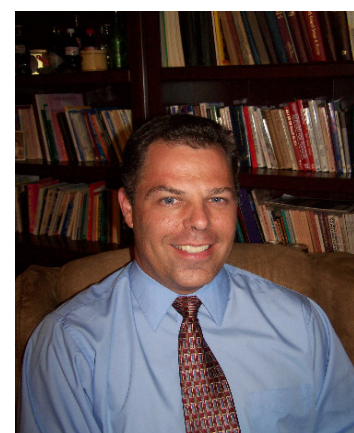

“AS THE BIBLE SCHOOL GOES - SO GOES THE CHURCH”

This was a favorite phrase of Bro. Ira North. The Madison Church of Christ at one time had the largest Bible School of the churches of Christ in the world. Congregations from all over the United States traveled to Madison to see how to have a good Bible school. Once each month they would put on a Bible School workshop for all who wanted to come.

The Bible teaches us to “Go ye therefore and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen” (Matthew 28:19-20). Notice the command - “Teaching them to observe all things” - where do you do that? In the Sunday morning Bible School. The great Apostle Paul said, “And the things that that thou has heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men who shall be able to teach others also” (2 Timothy 2:2). Where do you do that? In The Bible School. Peter instructs, “But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ....”(2 Peter 3:18). Where do you grow in knowledge? In the Bible School.

Many Congregations treat the Bible School like it’s a necessary evil. It’s like, “Well, I guess since we must we’ll have it.” They never promote it or help teachers become better. It’s just there. Bro. J.J. Turner has an excellent book entitled, *Healthy Churches Are Learning Churches*. He emphasizes the need for us to make a change to become learning churches and not just pew fillers.

Satan is after you. The world is alluring. The only thing that will combat it is the word of God. David said, “Thy word have I hid in my heart that I might not sin against thee” (Psalm 119:11). How do you do that? --The Bible School.

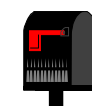
