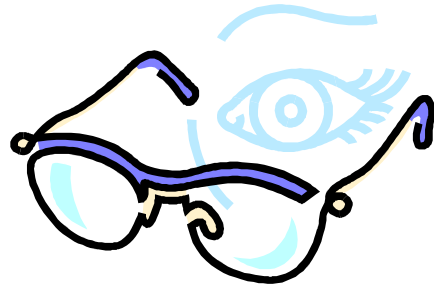


Hind Sight is 20/20!
