

## What can I do for the upcoming Gospel Meeting?

Our fall Gospel Meeting with **Brother Curtis Cates** is only a few weeks away. For the meeting to be successful, we all need to be busy working now! Wouldn't it be wonderful to have 300 in attendance on Sunday? Let's make that our goal! Here are a few suggestions how to reach that goal:

First, everyone must **ATTEND!** Let's all make a concerted effort to be here! If all *our* members at Adamsville were here we would almost attain the goal! On any given Sunday there will be 25 to 50 who are not at worship. Many don't have a reason for not being there, they are simply forsaking. Remember the words found in Hebrews, "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching" (Hebrews 10:25).

Secondly, we can accomplish our goal if we **ADVERTISE** the meeting. Who will *you* invite this year? Don't look at anyone else this is our responsibility! Remember the Lord's command in Mark 16:15, "Go ye unto all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature." Our community is the world! All you have to do is ask them to come; Brother Cates will do the hard part! As Christians we are to encourage one another. "Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ" (Galatians 6:2). The Lord recognized the importance of encouragement when He sent out the seventy He sent them out "...two and two..." Remember also to look for erring Christians who need to make their lives right, they need to be here! In the third place, let's **ASK GOD** to help us. One of the greatest things you and I can do for this Gospel Meeting is to pray. Pray for strength to do our work. Lord, give us the courage to encourage and invite. Pray for the erring. Lord, may the words of exhortation fall upon honest and good hearts and bring forth much fruit in thy vineyard. Pray for the speaker. Lord, grant him the knowledge of thy word. Give him the wisdom to say what each of us needs to hear. Pray for the listeners. Lord, may thy words prick our hearts and cause us to do what we need to do to be in the proper relationship with Thee!
